



Possible Eagle Scout Projects At Hawthorn Hollow

1. Redirecting a trail along the Pike Creek that is being eroded from underneath.
2. Restoring benches and creating new benches along our trails.
3. Original prairie restoration. A significant amount of woodland needs to be converted back to prairie. Buckthorn along with many other trees need to be removed.
4. Remove invasive Buckthorn from targeted areas.
5. Remove invasive Garlic Mustard from targeted areas (May project).
6. Build a bridge over a drainage area in the restored prairie.
7. Build and install boot scraping stations (minimum of two) and educational signs near trailheads. This is for the prevention of spread of invasive species.
8. Design and install a wigwam for educational purposes along our “Old Indian Trail”.



We look forward to working with potential eagle scouts. We ask to coordinate with the scout whose project it is with limited involvement from adult leaders and parents.
