**Dear Artist,**

We invite you to participate in the 17<sup>th</sup> Annual “Walk in the Woods” Art Fair, sponsored by Hawthorn Hollow Nature Sanctuary and Arboretum. The emphasis of this show is for the display and sale of quality fine arts. The artist exhibits are located along wooded trails and in the gardens of this beautiful Nature Sanctuary. We are located 5 miles east of I-94 on Highway 31 between Kenosha and Racine Wisconsin.

**Date/Hours** **Saturday** September 5, 2009  
10:00 AM – 4:00 PM. No rain date is scheduled.

**Eligibility** This fair is open to professional artists and fine crafts persons. All work must be original in design and concept, and created by the applying artist. No items made from commercial kits, prefabricated forms, or molds may be displayed or sold. Mass produced and imported items are not allowed.

This is a juried show. If collaborative, all artists must be listed and juried. All artists are required to submit three photographs of their work

You will be notified by mail of your acceptance status by **July 15<sup>th</sup> 2009**, and will receive more details and directions at that time. If your application is not accepted, your exhibition site fee and photographs will be returned to you at this time.

**Exhibits** Site size may vary, but most are 10’ x 12’, and all are outdoors on grass or wood chips. You are offered a selection of size and location for your exhibition site on the Entry Form (backside), which will be honored on a first come, first served, basis. We will have a crew and vehicles available to assist you with transporting your wares to and from your site, if needed.

You may set up on Friday September 4<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 AM until 7:00 PM, or after 6:30 AM on Saturday.

**Fees** \$90.00 per artist for exhibition site (\$110.00 after June 30, 2009) There will be no refund after the application has been accepted. If a collaborative site is requested \$35.00 per additional artist is required.

**Promotion** Extensive local and regional advertising through newspapers, various community and statewide publications, radio, flyers and mailings, as well as the beautiful setting have attracted excellent crowds (3000+) in past years.

**Other Features** A silent Auction, live music and entertainment, and a variety of food and beverages will be offered throughout the grounds during the day.
