## **CLASS DESCRIPTIONS**

## **Bat House Building Workshop**

Build a multi-chambered bat house and learn about Wisconsin bats and the threat they face at this workshop. Participants will each receive a multi-chambered bat house kit and will assemble it during class.

Participants will also learn the ideal location to install their newly built bat house. Your new bat house should be installed in fall or early spring so that it's in place when the hibernating bats wake up and leave their hibernacula for the summer. If you are lucky, bats could take up residence in your bat house during the summer of 2013. Sometimes it takes several years before bats find a newly installed bat house.
